Ryoko Mori was born in Tokyo, Japan. From an early age she studied piano and soon developed an interest in the organ. She studied organ at Ferris University, and the Tokyo University of Fine Arts with Prof. Masaaki Suzuki founder of the famous Bach Collegium Japan. She also completed further studies at Baylor University, in Dallas, Texas.

In 2005 along with Melbourne organist Rhys Boak, Ryoko was the first organist to give a series of organ recitals in mainland China at the Gulangyu Organ Museum, Xiamen, China

She has an interest in preserving historic instruments such as the organ here at East Melbourne, and has already recorded 3 CDs of Melbourne historic organs... 'Organs of the Ballarat Goldfields' (Move MD 3294), 'Organs of the Antipodes' (Move MCD 315) and 'Totally Tubular' an independent release sponsored by Wakeley Pipe Organs.
